Covid 19 - WA Racing & Pinjarra Harness Racing Club Update

In line with WA Government Health rules

- All Patrons must only enter through the main gates on Paceway Court
- All Patrons must show proof (digital or paper-based form) of vaccination (double dose) or medical exemption at the entry gates upon arrival to the track.
- All Patrons must show proof of identification (ID) at the entry gates upon arrival at the track.
- Failure to provide one or both above will unfortunately result in entry to the racetrack being refused
- All patrons fully vaccinated upon entry being granted to the racetrack shall be provided with a colour wristband that must be always worn whilst at the track.
- All Patrons must also check in using the SafeWA app or a manual contact register upon gaining entry to the track.

Ongoing proof of vaccination requirements

Proof of vaccination (double dose) by patrons is required for race meetings at the Pinjarra Harness Racing Club as announced by the <u>WA Government</u> for the Peel Region.

Industry Participants & Essential Personnel

All industry participants and essential personnel <u>must</u> only enter and leave the track through the float gate, located towards the southern end of the racetrack along South West Highway.

Access to the track via the main gates off Paceway Court is not permitted

At this time, industry participants and essential personnel working at race meetings <u>must</u> show their identification (RWWA Licence Card) at the entry gate but are not required to show proof of vaccination while working in work areas such as mounting yards, parade rings and horse stalls.

However, industry participants and essential personnel <u>must</u> provide proof of being double-dose vaccinated against COVID-19 prior to entering patron areas of the Pinjarra Harness Racing Club (all areas except the stalls complex).

Industry participants and essential personnel wanting to access patron areas during the day must report to proceed to the race day office in the stalls complex to provide proof of vaccination to staff and be issued with a colour wristband.

Industry participants and essential personnel not vaccinated (double dose) shall not be allowed entry to Patron areas.

Proof may be a digital or paper-based form, along with approved RWWA licence card

Industry participants and essential personnel shall then be provided with a coloured wristband based to allow entry to Patron areas.

Essential personnel and industry participants must also check in using the SafeWA app or a manual contact register upon gaining entry to the track.

- Essential personnel & Industry participants at the southern entry point to the stalls complex or the race day office in the stalls complex.

Entry to Patron areas without a race club issued wristband by racing participants and essential personnel is not permitted.

Training and Trials

Proof of vaccination will not apply for training or race trials but check in using the SafeWA app or a manual contact register continues to be mandatory.

Apart from these requirements, race meetings, trials and trackwork will proceed as normal unless advised otherwise. Please ensure appropriate physical distancing and good hygiene practices.

These measures will be reviewed regularly, and the Chief Health Officer will continue to monitor the situation and provide advice to RWWA and in turn the Pinjarra Harness Racing Club.

A number of additional potential exposure sites have been identified across Western Australia. Exposure sites are listed on the HealthyWA website. It is likely more sites will be added and people are encouraged to keep checking the site regularly. Anyone who has been to any of the exposure sites should follow the relevant testing and quarantine instructions.
